Regarding the August 23 letter referenced below, please be aware that the company has regularly taken the initiative to communicate with town officials on a wide variety of issues related to water service. Statements in the letter misinterpret information provided to the Hampton Select Board concerning the current drought, which should not be interpreted as a comprehensive summary of the company's long term supply and demand management program. Being a multi-town water system utilizing State-owned water resources, the company incorporates supply and demand management evaluations into its long range planning. The possibility of connecting the Wiggin Way subdivision is a matter under discussion, but has been following appropriate DES and PUC procedures.
