Means Test for Concord Steam Customer Converting to Natural Gas

Using 2015 Concord Steam bills determine the annual aggregate Mlb usage by meter size.

Calculate the annual energy cost for Concord Steam service by multiplying aggregate Mlb usage by the current Concord Steam combined usage and COE rates.¹

Calculate the annual energy cost for Liberty Utilities service by multiplying aggregate Mlb usage by the current steam equivalent rate for a Liberty.²

Calculate the annual aggregate energy savings by meter size.

Calculate the total energy savings for all buildings/meters.

Divide actual or estimated conversion cost by total annual savings to determine the simple payback.
