**Joint Petition to Establish Interconnection/Transition Fund for
Non-Governmental Concord Steam Customers**

Petition to Intervene of CATCH Neighborhood Housing

NOW COMES, CATCH Neighborhood Housing and respectfully moves the Commission grant its intervention in this matter, pursuant to RSA 541-A:32 and Puc 203.17, and states as follows:

1. Petitioner is a non-profit providing affordable housing and property management services to tenants in and around Concord area.
2. Petitioner is a non-governmental Concord Steam customer that needs to transition off of Concord Steam service, and that supports the *Joint Petition to Establish Interconnection/Transition Fund for Non-Governmental Concord Steam Customers (Joint Petition)*.
3. Therefore, an order on the merits of the *Joint Petition* may have an impact on CATCH Neighborhood Housing's "rights, duties, privileges, immunities or other substantial interests may be affected by the proceeding." RSA 541-A:32, I(b).
4. As a result, CATCH Neighborhood Housing seeks intervention in this matter, and also expresses its support of the *Joint Petition*.

WHEREFORE, CATCH Neighborhood Housing respectfully asks that the Commission:

- (a) Grant CATCH Neighborhood Housing intervention petition; and
- (b) Grant such other relief as is just.


