Notice of Material Change

Dear Executive Director:

In Constellation NewEnergy, Inc.'s ("CNE") renewal application filed earlier this year, CNE stated that it intended to serve new residential and small commercial customers; however, on October 25, 2017, CNE decided that it will no longer solicit or enroll these classes of customers. As such, CNE is notifying the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission that CNE no longer intends to solicit new residential or small commercial customers under 20kW, but will continue to provide service to our current residential or small commercial customers on term contracts, through the end of their existing terms. The longest term contract ends on September 28, 2021. CNE will send each residential or small commercial customer under 20kW a termination notice 45-60 days prior to their contract expiration explaining that if they fail to select another supplier they will be dropped back to the utility after contract expiration.
