Dear Ms. Howland:

On June 5, 2017, Northern Utilities, Inc., filed a petition to implement new permanent rates and to amend various tariffs for effect July 5, 2017 and to set temporary rates for effect August 1, 2017 (if the Commission suspended the effective date of the permanent rates). The Commission issued Order No. 26,024 (June 15, 2017) which suspended the proposed rates and tariffs and scheduled a pre-hearing conference for July 6, 2017 and a hearing on temporary rates for July 24, 2017.

The Office of Consumer Advocate (OCA) filed a letter on April 26, 2017 indicating its participation in the docket.

Following the July 6th pre-hearing conference, the parties met in a technical session to establish a proposed procedural schedule for this proceeding.
