Re: DW 18-101 – Pennichuck East Utility, Inc. Petition for Approval of Special Contract for Woodmont Commons Partial Assented-to Motion for Extension of Time Staff Recommendation

Dear Ms. Howland:

On August 26, 2019, Pennichuck East Utilities, Inc. (PEU) filed a Partial Assented-to Motion for an Extension of Time (Motion) to file an executed copy of its special contract with Pillsbury Realty Development, LLC (Pillsbury) and a statement of special circumstances. Staff recommends the Commission approve PEU's Motion with conditions.

In accordance with Commission Order No. 26,285 (August 9, 2019) approving PEU's special contract with Pillsbury, the requested documentation was to be submitted to the Commission by August 26, 2019. In its Motion, PEU stated that the parties have not signed the special contract because the planned water storage tank is still under scrutiny by the Town of Londonderry Zoning Board of Adjustment (Londonderry ZBA). As such, PEU and Pillsbury believe that it is premature to sign the contract before it receives all regulatory approvals. Thus, PEU requests that the Commission grant an extension of time for filing the signed special contract until thirty days following the date of finalization of the Londonderry ZBA's decision. PEU states that Pillsbury assents to the requested relief.

While Staff sympathizes with PEU's and Pillsbury's desire to defer execution of the special contract until finalization of the Londonderry ZBA's decision, it is concerned by the length of time that may be required for that to occur and the potential impact that may have relative to the contract's provisions previously approved by the Commission. Therefore, Staff recommends the Commission approve PEU's Motion under the condition that it file periodic updates every three months with the Commission explaining

the status of the approval process with the Londonderry ZBA and final execution of the special contract. Staff also recommends the Commission provide for the potential of reevaluating the provisions previously approved within the special contract if the circumstance arises whereby PEU does not receive all of the necessary regulatory approvals to execute the special contract within the next nine months.
