On October 3, 2018, Summit Energy Services, Inc. d/b/a Schneider Electric (Summit Energy) submitted an application with the Commission to renew its registration as a provider of natural gas aggregation service.


Commission Staff filed a memorandum on October 31, 2018, in which it confirmed its review of the application and its conclusion that the application meets the requirements for registration under N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3000. Staff recommended that Summit Energy's registration application be approved for a five-year term, beginning on February 6, 2019.

The Commission has approved Staff's recommendation. Accordingly, Summit Energy's application for registration is approved, effective as of February 6, 2019. The renewed registration is for a term of five years and expires at the close of business on February 6, 2024. Pursuant to Puc 3003.05(a), you must submit your next renewal application at least 60 days prior to the expiration of the approved registration term, on or before December 8, 2023.

Please be aware that registered providers of natural gas aggregation service are subject to specific requirements contained in N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 3000 – Competitive Natural Gas Supplier and Aggregator Rules. These rules are available at: <http://www.puc.nh.gov/Regulatory/Rules/PUC3000.pdf>.

Please note that each registered natural gas aggregator is subject to an annual assessment of \$2,000, unless it demonstrates that its gross revenue in New Hampshire during the preceding fiscal year (from July 1 through June 30) was less than \$10,000, pursuant to RSA 363-A:2, III and 5.
