1	PROCEEDING
2	CHAIRMAN HONIGBERG: We are here
3	today in Docket DW 19-031, which is a petition
4	by Hampstead Area Water Company to provide
5	service in an additional part of Sandown, a
6	delightfully named division called "Kelly
7	Green". This is a prehearing conference that
8	will be followed by a technical session.
9	Before we do anything else, let's
10	take appearances.
11	MR. AUGERI: Thank you. Attorney
12	Tony Augeri, on behalf of HAWC. With me is our
13	consultant, Steve St. Cyr; the Company's
14	President, Harold Morse; the Controller, John
15	Sullivan; the Vice President, Chris Lewis
16	Morse; and the Company's General Manager,
17	Charles Lanza.
18	MR. TUOMALA: Good morning,
19	Commissioners. Christopher Tuomala, for the
20	Public Utilities Commission. With me I have
21	Anthony Leone, Utility Analyst in the Gas &
22	Water Division; Robyn Descoteau, a Utility
23	Analyst with the Gas & Water Division; and
24	Jayson Laflamme, the Assistant Director of the
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1 Gas & Water Division. CHAIRMAN HONIGBERG: The primary 2 3 purpose of the prehearing conference is for the 4 parties to state their preliminary positions 5 for us. 6 Are there any issues we need to deal 7 with before that happens? MR. AUGERI: There are not. 8 9 CHAIRMAN HONIGBERG: All right. 10 Mr. Augeri, why don't you start us off. 11 MR. AUGERI: Thank you very much. 12 Hampstead Area Water Company, "HAWC" 13 for short, is presently franchised throughout 14 Rockingham County, primarily in Hampstead and 15 in Atkinson, New Hampshire. We received a 16 request from a developer, Lewis Builders, Inc., 17 for a new system in the Town of Sandown for a 18 22-unit townhouse-style apartment complex known 19 as "Kelly Green". 20 There is currently an easement for a 21 water system and related facilities that the 22 Company has been granted. We intend to have --23 we're seeking the franchise -- to expand the 24 franchise to provide water service to these {DW 19-031} [Prehearing conference] {05-08-19}

1	people. The proposed franchise expansion area
2	also includes would include and combine two
3	existing franchises in Sandown; one being
4	Fairfield and the other being Mill Woods.
5	The Mill Woods is to honor the
6	request of a homeowner that is currently
7	outside of the current franchise area, within
8	their franchise area, and then also to include
9	this new 22-unit apartment complex, the
10	townhouse-style.
11	We'll be able to serve this under the
12	provisions of the PUC, if granted. The
13	construction of the proposed system will be
14	done by Lewis Builders Development, Inc., which
15	is a through its subsidiary-related company
16	HAWSCO, Hampstead Area Water Services Company,
17	they're a division of Lewis Builders
18	Development, Inc.
19	The total cost of this system will be
20	\$70,500, of that it will be less, approximately
21	\$11,500, which is contributed to the
22	developer from the developer to HAWC under a
23	contribution in aid of construction, CIAC.
24	The Petition itself, just by way of
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1 brief procedural history, was filed on January 29th, 2019. Staff has already issued 2 3 data requests, which were done on April 3rd, 4 and HAWC has responded to those data requests 5 on April 17th. So, we're a bit on, you know, down the road a little bit. 6 7 I will mention as well that there was the need to revise two exhibits that were 8 9 originally submitted, so that it captured in 10 the letter to the Town and notice to the Town 11 the complete proposed franchise area expansion 12 that we're seeking, and that was done on 13 April 18th of 2019. 14 So, we believe it will be in the 15 public good if the Commission were to grant and 16 extend and expand this franchise area for HAWC, 17 to add the proposed satellite system to our 18 current franchises, to be permitted to acquire 19 these assets, and to charge our existing 20 consolidated rate, which was submitted as part 21 of the original Petition. And that we would 22 hope that the Commission would issue an order 23 granting those requests. 24 We look forward to working with the

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1 Staff and OCA, and hopefully to reach an agreement that would be submitted to the 2 3 Commission for approval. 4 Thank you. 5 CHAIRMAN HONIGBERG: Thank you, 6 Mr. Augeri. Mr. Tuomala. 7 MR. TUOMALA: Thank you, Mr. 8 Chairman. The Commission Staff has reviewed the 9 10 filing. And as Attorney Augeri had mentioned, 11 we have propounded one set of data requests, to 12 which the Company promptly responded to. After 13 the review of all those documents, there are 14 still a few questions and issues that remain, 15 specifically the income tax liability 16 associated with the receipt of the CIAC that 17 Attorney Augeri had mentioned. And also, we're 18 looking at the greater size of the franchise 19 area that the attorney had already mentioned as 20 well. 21 We look forward to working with the 22 Company at the following technical session and 23 to resolve these issues in a timely manner. 24 Thank you.

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1 CHAIRMAN HONIGBERG: What do you anticipate for a timeline on this one? 2 3 MR. TUOMALA: Depending on the outcome of today's discussions with our 4 5 follow-up questions, I would think that we 6 would probably have another round of discovery 7 in about a two to three week turnaround time, and then a few more weeks after that for a 8 9 Staff recommendation. So, I would say, at a 10 maximum, unless things -- there's an unforeseen 11 problem at today's technical session, about a 12 month and a half. 13 CHAIRMAN HONIGBERG: Commissioner 14 Bailey. 15 CMSR. BAILEY: Mr. Augeri, I looked 16 at the map that shows the two existing 17 franchise areas and the big circle around both 18 that combine it all into one franchise area. 19 Is it the Company's intention to serve any 20 customer in that area that asks in the future? 21 MR. AUGERI: It is the intent to 22 serve any customer that would ask, yes. 23 CMSR. BAILEY: So, would you have a 24 main that went between the two existing {DW 19-031} [Prehearing conference] {05-08-19}

1 franchise territories? Well, you can --MR. AUGERI: I would defer to, you 2 3 know, the General Manager, who is more 4 boots-on-the-ground on that. But --5 CMSR. BAILEY: You can talk that over with Staff. 6 7 MR. AUGERI: Yes. CMSR. BAILEY: And just make sure 8 that it's clear when you file your 9 10 recommendation. Thank you. 11 MR. AUGERI: Yes. Thank you. 12 CHAIRMAN HONIGBERG: Commissioner 13 Giaimo. 14 CMSR. GIAIMO: I have one question. 15 There's a \$10,000 CIAC, and then I believe I 16 read in Mr. St. Cyr's testimony that there's 17 another \$45,000 CIAC in the form of in plant. 18 What does that entail? What specifically is 19 that \$45,000 associated with? 20 MR. AUGERI: Do you know which exhibit that was on the filing? 21 22 CMSR. GIAIMO: I believe it was 23 Exhibit 8. 24 MR. AUGERI: All right. I'll have {DW 19-031} [Prehearing conference] {05-08-19}

1 Mr. St. Cyr speak to that. MR. ST. CYR: So, if you look at --2 3 is this on? So, if you look at the schedules 4 attached to my testimony, under SPS-5, you see 5 the total cost of the plant and the allocation of the contribution in aid of construction 6 7 associated with the plant. That's SPS-5. The lower half shows the contribution in aid of 8 construction. And this is the contribution 9 10 from the developer that we're allocating to the 11 various plant accounts. 12 CMSR. GIAIMO: Thank you. 13 CHAIRMAN HONIGBERG: All right. Ιf 14 there's nothing else, we will adjourn the 15 prehearing conference and leave you to your 16 technical session. Thank you all. 17 (Whereupon the prehearing 18 conference was adjourned at 19 10:12 a.m., and a technical 20 session was held thereafter.) 21 22 23 24

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
