Important Message for Customers Regarding Electricity Rates

On April 30, 2019, Liberty Utilities ("Liberty") submitted a rate filing with the New Hampshire Public Utilities Commission ("PUC") to increase base rates, which recover the cost of the distribution system used to deliver electricity to customers. Customers should expect to see a temporary increase in rates sometime this summer while the Commission reviews Liberty's request. A decision on Liberty's request is expected within twelve months, and the temporary rates will be reconciled with the final approved rates. Liberty has proposed an annual revenue increase of \$5.7 million. For residential customers using 650 kilowatt hours, per month, the monthly bill impact would be approximately \$7.75 or 6.27% as compared to the rates in effect today.
