Dear Chairman Goldner:

On behalf of Liberty Utilities (Granite State Electric) Corp. d/b/a Liberty, I write to request that the Commission indicate Exhibit 82, which was reserved for proposed revisions to the decoupling tariff, may be closed without a further filing by the Company because the Commission's recent order in Docket No. DE 22-052 approved revised decoupling language and the Company filed a compliance tariff with those changes on January 5, 2023. Order No. 26,748 (Dec. 16, 2022).

In a prior order that otherwise approved a step adjustment, the Commission had reserved Exhibit 82 "for any revised tariff provisions and other materials related to decoupling," stating: "We approve the filed decoupling tariff, but encourage OCA, Staff and Liberty to review the tariff in more detail and propose changes as appropriate." Order No. 26,494 at 2, 7 (July 1, 2021).

In light of the Commission's recent approval of the revised tariff language and the Company's January 5, 2023, compliance filing with that language, the Company asks the Commission to indicate that Exhibit 82 may be closed without a further filing.
