To the Parties:

On July 11, 2019, the Commission held a duly noticed prehearing conference in the above-referenced matter. Appearances were entered by Public Service Company of New Hampshire d/b/a Eversource Energy (Eversource), the Office of Consumer Advocate (OCA), and Commission Staff (Staff). The Commission granted petitions to intervene filed by Clean Energy New Hampshire (CENH) and Conservation Law Foundation (CLF).

Following the prehearing conference, Eversource, OCA, CENH, CLF, and Staff met in a technical session and agreed upon the following schedule, which Staff submitted to the Commission by letter dated July 12, 2019:


