Dear Ms. Howland:

Northern Utilities, Inc. ("Northern" or the "Company") agreed to make a supplemental Integrated Resource Plan filing in this docket to address certain issues raised by Commission Staff and the Office of Consumer Advocate ("OCA") at a technical session on December 11, 2019. The Company originally intended to submit its supplemental filing on or before January 31, 2020, but was subsequently granted an extension to February 28, 2020. On behalf of Northern, I enclose for filing the following:

1. An original and six confidential copies of the Company's revised 2019 Integrated Resource Plan and Appendices; and
2. One redacted copy of Company's revised 2019 Integrated Resource Plan and Appendices.

The Company has made numerous changes to the IRP to address issues raised at the December 11, 2019 technical session, including:

- Table III-2 has been updated;
- Table V-14 has been updated to identify the correct year;
- Sec VI.B now includes updates to discussion of Resource Impact Categories;
- Text in Sec VI.C.3 and Table VIII-1 have been updated;

- Sec IX.C.4, now includes Environmental Impact, Economic Development and Health & Safety as Qualitative Assessment categories
