Application to Renew Registration as a Provider of Electric Aggregation Service

Dear Mr. Lento:

On December 10, 2019, US Grid Energy, LLC (US Grid) submitted an application with the Commission to renew its registration as a provider of electric aggregation service.

Commission Staff filed a memorandum on December 16, 2019, in which it confirmed its review of the application and its conclusion that the application is complete. Staff recommended that US Grid's registration renewal application be approved for a two-year term, beginning on February 11, 2020, pursuant to Puc 2003.06(e)(1).

Your application for registration renewal is approved effective as of February 11, 2020, under Puc 2003.06(e)(1). The renewed registration is for a term of two years and expires at the close of business on February 11, 2022. Pursuant to Puc 2003.06(a), you must submit your next renewal application at least 60 days prior to the expiration of the approved registration term, on or before December 13, 2021.

Please be aware that registered providers of electric aggregation service are subject to specific requirements contained in N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 2000 – Competitive Electric Power Supplier and Aggregator Rules. These rules are available at: http://www.puc.nh.gov/Regulatory/Rules/PUC2000.pdf.
