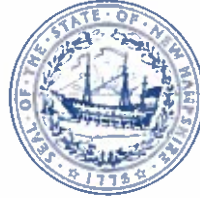

To the Parties:

On December 3, 2018, the Commission held a duly noticed prehearing conference in the above referenced matter. Appearances were entered by Aquarion Water Company of New Hampshire, Inc., the Town of Hampton, and Commission Staff. The motion to intervene of the Town of Hampton was granted.
