Revised Procedural Schedule

To the Parties:

On Friday, September 14, 2007, counsel for FairPoint filed a request to extend certain deadlines pertaining to FairPoint's rebuttal testimony in Docket No. DT 07-011. The request specifically noted that the existing discovery schedule would not change with respect to data requests propounded to Verizon. Counsel certified that the Office of Consumer Advocate, Verizon, and Staff assented to FairPoint's request.

The Commission has determined that the proposed changes will not unduly delay the proceeding or adversely affect the rights of any party.
